Dear Mr Papalia *Paul*

Thank you for your letter dated 17 June 2014 regarding parking at Makybe Rise Primary School.

The Department of Education has advised that a traffic management engineer has been engaged to design and cost several car parking options to better manage the high traffic volume currently experienced at Makybe Rise Primary School.

I am advised that funding has been allocated to commence the upgrade of the existing car park off Makybe Drive, which will provide an additional 19 bays. These works will include the installation of a raised pedestrian crossing to enable the City of Rockingham, Main Roads WA and the Western Australian Police to provide the much needed children's crossing on Makybe Drive. The Department advises that a temporary limestone car park will also be constructed to the south of this permanent car park, providing a further 20 bays. These works are to commence immediately.

In addition, I understand that the Department is currently in negotiations with the City of Rockingham to convert a number of existing street embayments to the north of the school into a 'Kiss and Drop' facility.

The Department is also negotiating the installation of street embayment parking on the roads bounding the school. I have been informed that at this stage there has been no funding commitment made by the City of Rockingham for this to proceed.
