Re: Pedestrian crossing installation at Singleton Primary School Crossing

I have been contacted by the President of the Singleton Primary School P&C, Mrs Nikki Spagnolo, regarding delays to the installation of a Type A pedestrian crossing at the school.

Mrs Spagnolo has advised that despite applying for the crossing in November 2013, having the required surveys completed in December 2013 and an onsite meeting with all stakeholders in March 2014, the school community is still waiting for the crossing to be installed.

I understand that there have been difficulties due to the need to relocate a bus stop and that the City of Rockingham is currently in negotiations with the Public Transport Authority over this. However, the problems appear to be increasing with Mrs Spagnolo advising that since November last year one child has been struck by a vehicle and there have been seven near misses.

In view of the delays outlined in Mrs Spagnolo's correspondence, a copy of which I have enclosed, I would appreciate any assistance you can provide in getting the matter resolved and thereby improving the safety of the children attending Singleton Primary School.
